



Mark 12:35 while Jesus taught in the temple, He asked...  
Luke 21:37 in the day time, He was teaching in the temple  
Matt. 26:55 Jesus said -- I sat daily with you, teaching  
in the temple -- (also, Mark 14:49 and  
Luke 22:53)

\* Jesus taught in their synagogues

Mark 1:21 Jesus went into Capernaum -- He entered into  
the synagogue on the Sabbath day -- He  
taught  
Matt. 4:23 Jesus went about all Galilee -- teaching in their  
synagogues -- (also, Mark 1:39 and Luke 4:15,44)  
Luke 4:15 Jesus taught in their synagogues  
16 in Nazareth, Jesus went into the synagogue on  
the Sabbath day and stood up to read  
17-19 He read from Isaiah  
28-29 the people were filled with wrath toward Him  
Luke 6:6 on another Sabbath, Jesus entered into the  
synagogue and taught  
Matt. 9:35 Jesus went about all the cities and villages --  
teaching in their synagogues  
Matt. 12:9 Jesus went into their synagogue  
Matt. 13:54 Jesus taught them in their synagogue  
Luke 13:10 Jesus was teaching in one of the synagogues on the  
Sabbath  
John 6:59 Jesus taught these things in the synagogue in  
Capernaum

\* Jesus' warnings about synagogues

Matt. 6:2 hypocrites -- giving alms in the synagogue  
and in the streets -- to be seen of men  
5 hypocrites -- love to pray standing in the  
synagogues and in the corners of the streets -- to be seen of men  
Matt. 10:17 beware of men -- they will deliver you up to  
the councils, and they will scourge you  
in their synagogues -- (also, Luke  
12:11)  
Matt. 23:6 some loved the chief seats in the synagogues --  
(also, Mark 12:39 and Luke 20:46)  
Matt. 23:34 to the religious leaders -- you will scourge  
them in your synagogues  
Mark 13:9 take heed to yourselves -- for they shall  
deliver you up to councils -- and you shall be beaten in the  
synagogues -- (also, Luke 21:12)  
John 9:22 if any man did confess that He was Christ,  
that person was to be put out of the  
synagogue  
John 12:42 they did not confess Him, lest they should be put  
out of the synagogue  
John 16:2 they shall put you out of the synagogues

Rev. 2:9 I know the blasphemy of those who say they  
are Jews and are not -- but are the  
synagogue of Satan  
Rev. 3:9 I will make them of the synagogue of Satan  
(who say they are Jews and are not) to  
worship your feet

APOSTLES TAUGHT IN THE TEMPLE AND IN SYNAGOGUES

---

\* Apostles taught in the temple

Acts 3:12-26 after Peter and John healed a man in the  
temple, Peter spoke powerful words  
Acts 5:17-20 after the apostles were imprisoned, an angel  
instructed them to go speak in the  
temple  
25 a messenger told the high priest and chief  
priests that the imprisoned men were teaching the people in the  
temple  
Acts 5:42 they taught daily in the temple and in every  
house -- teaching and preaching Jesus  
Christ

\* Apostles taught in the synagogues

Acts 9:2 Paul beat believers in the synagogues --  
(also, Acts 22:19 and Acts 26:11)  
Acts 9:20 after Saul received the laying on of hands,  
he began preaching in the synagogues  
that Christ is the Son of God  
Acts 13:5 at Salamis, Barnabas and Saul preached the  
word of God in the synagogues of the  
Jews  
Acts 13:14 at Antioch In Pisidia, Barnabas and Saul went into  
the synagogue on the Sabbath and sat  
down  
15-41 after the reading of the law and the  
prophets, Paul spoke  
44 the next Sabbath, almost the whole city came  
together to hear the word of God  
Acts 14:1 at Iconium, Barnabas and Saul went into the  
synagogue of the Jews and spoke  
Acts 17:1-3 at Thessalonica, Paul spoke in the synagogue  
for three straight Sabbaths -- reasoned  
with them out of the scriptures that  
this Jesus is the Christ

Acts 17:10 at Berea, Paul and Silas went into the syna-gogue  
of the Jews  
Acts 17:17 at Athens, Paul disputed in the synagogue with the  
Jews -- He also met daily with people in  
the market  
Acts 18:4 at Corinth, Paul reasoned in the synagogue  
every Sabbath  
Acts 18:19 at Ephesus, Paul entered into the synagogue and  
reasoned with the Jews  
Acts 18:26 Apollos began to speak boldly in the synagogue  
Acts 19:8 at Ephesus, Paul went into the synagogue and  
spoke boldly for 3 months

EXHORTING ONE ANOTHER

---

Heb. 10:25 exhorting one another  
24 let us consider one another -- to provoke unto  
love and good works

\* Exhorting

Rom. 12:8 the gift of exhortation  
Heb. 3:13 exhort one another daily

\* Edifying

Rom. 14:19 follow after the things which make for peace --  
and things wherewith one may edify  
another  
Rom. 15:2 let everyone of us please his neighbor for  
his good to edification  
1 Cor. 8:1 knowledge puffs up -- love edifies  
1 Cor. 14:3 he that prophesies speaks to edification,  
exhortation and comfort -- he that speaks in an unknown tongue  
edifies himself -- he that prophesies edifies the church  
Eph. 4:12 for the edifying of the body of Christ  
16 makes increase of the body -- unto the  
edifying of itself in love  
Eph. 4:29 no corrupt communication out of the mouth --  
the use of edifying -- that it may  
minister grace unto the hearers  
1 Thes. 5:11 comfort yourselves together and edify one  
another
